AAU organizes the Annual Graduation Gathering 2016

Under the slogan "You have been the ambassadors of science and knowledge and still you are", The Deanship of Student Affairs at Al Ain University –Al Ain Campus- organized the second Annual Graduation Gathering for its graduates, in the presence of Prof. Ghaleb El Refae –AAU President, Prof. Abdulhafeed Belarabi –AAU Vice President, Dr. Ibtehal Aburezeq –Dean of Student Affairs, Colleges Deans, Academic Staff and the graduates students from different batches.
